The **Evidence 2023 Capacities webinar series** aims to:

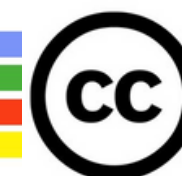
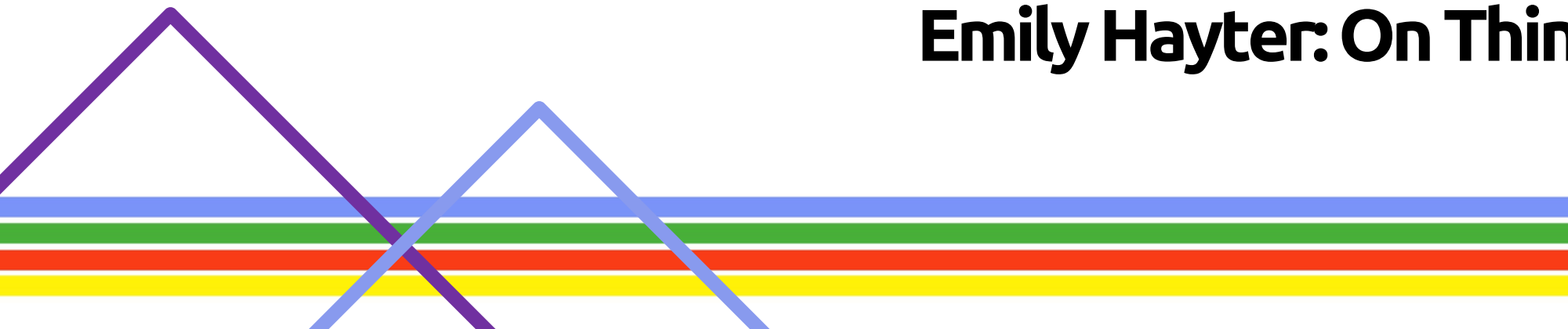
- create a platform for sharing experiences and ideas to enhance capacity for evidence use in Africa,

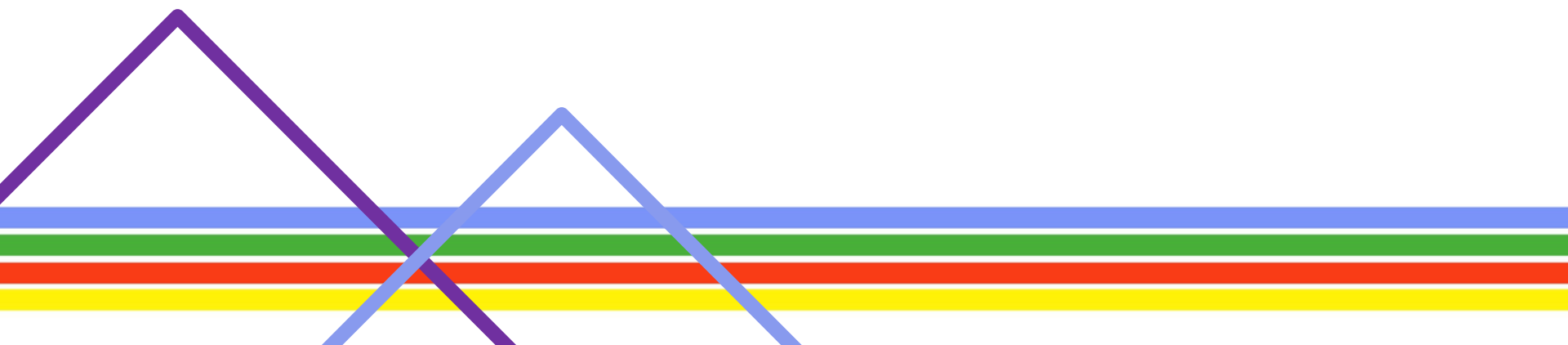

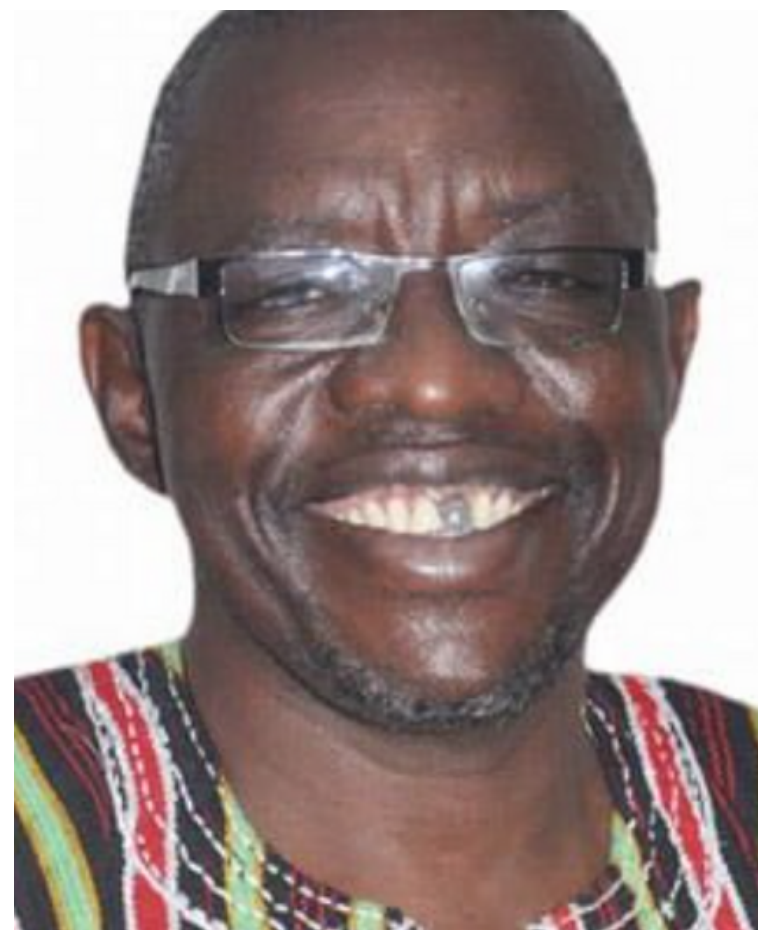


About the webinar today

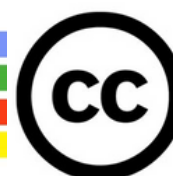
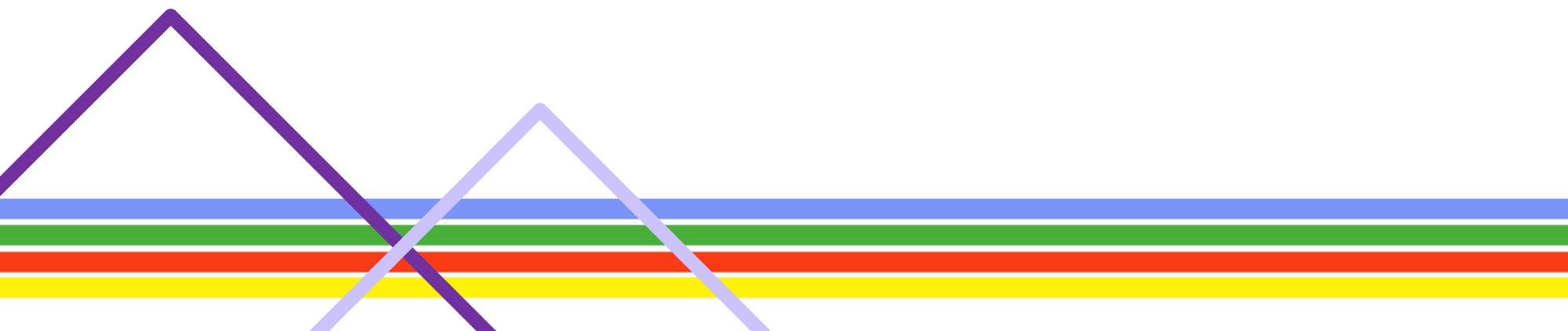
