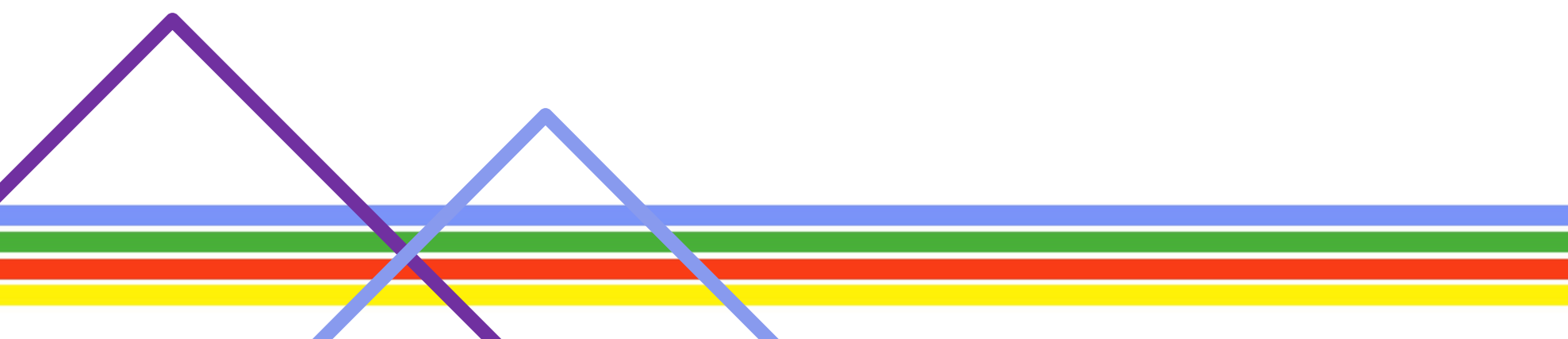


About the webinar series



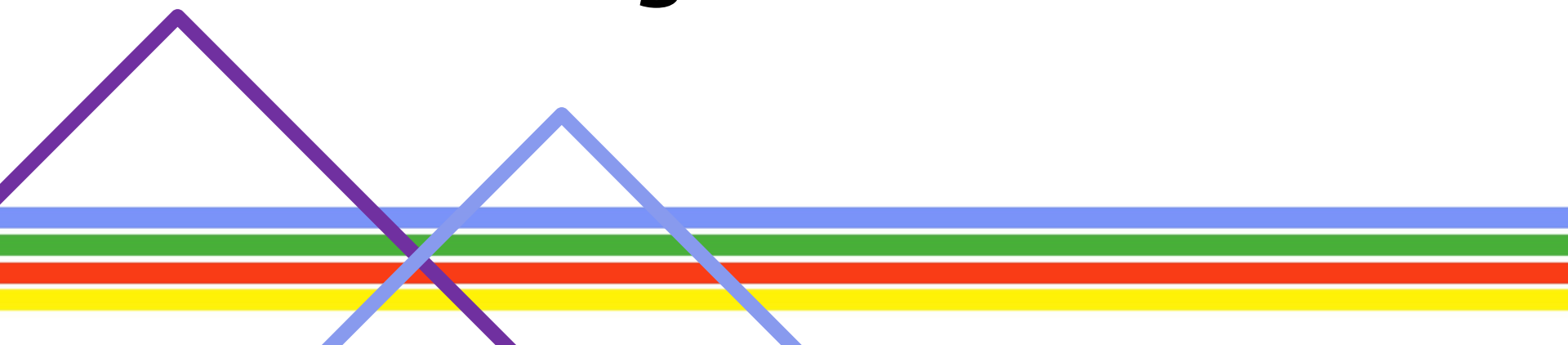
The **Evidence 2023 Capacities webinar series** aims to:

About the webinar today

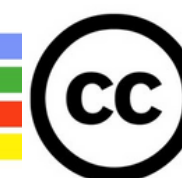
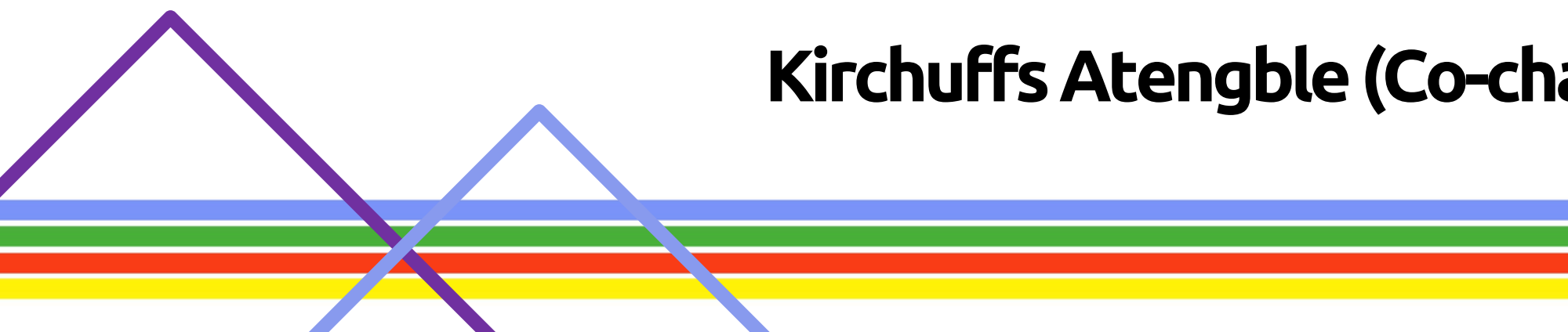
- The **objective of this session** is to harvest innovative approaches being deployed to address structural and value issues within evidence ecosystems in Africa.

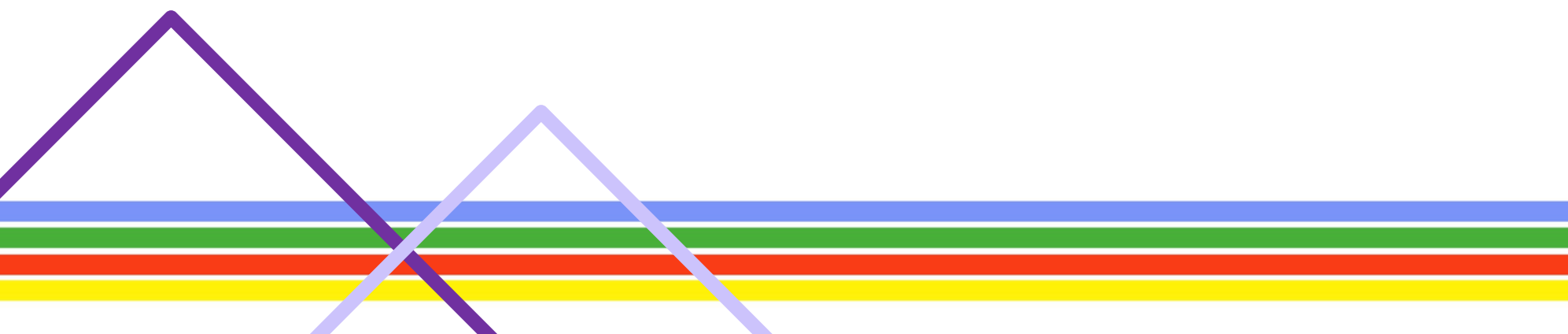
